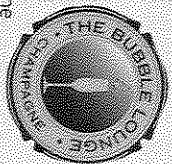

# Feeley Awarded Marshall Fellowship



Terri Feeley, executive director of Chamber-affiliate SFWorks, has been awarded a prestigious Marshall Memorial Fellowship. She will join emerging leaders from 17 states to spend three weeks in Europe learning about economic, political and social issues. Feeley is the only 2006 Fellow from San Francisco and was selected through a competitive, nationwide process involving candidates from politics, government, military, media, business and the nonprofit sector.

As executive director of SFWorks, Feeley partners with local businesses to create opportunities for low-income workers. She intends to use the fellowship opportunity to learn from best practices in European cities.

"I think the selection committee found my candidacy appealing because of my experience creating public-private partnerships," says Feeley. "I'm excited about the opportunity to exchange promising practices with our European hosts, and am certain that I'll return with lots of new ideas for SFWorks and San Francisco."
